

Mayan Families works to bring aid to impoverished families in the Western Highlands of Guatemala. This can mean bringing a basket of food to a family in need, building a house or school to replace one lost to a mudslide, paying for a student's scholarship, or bringing urgent medical care to those without access.

This time of year can be especially hard for impoverished families. With barely enough money to pay for the basic necessities, there is rarely any left over for gifts or festivities.
