

Mayan Families works to bring aid to impoverished families in the Western Highlands of Guatemala. This can mean bringing a fuel-efficient stove or water filter to a family in need, building a house or school to replace one lost to a mudslide, or paying for a student's scholarship, or bringing urgent medical care to those without access.

68% of indigenous children are malnourished, and 21.5% of Guatemalans survive on less than \$1 a day.

Traditional stoves fill the kitchen with thick, black smoke, and often cause long-term respiratory problems. A fuel-efficient stove cuts these health risks significantly while also lowering monthly fuel costs.
