

Mayan Families works to bring aid to impoverished families in the Western Highlands of Guatemala. This can mean bringing a fuel-efficient stove or water filter to a family in need, building a house or school to replace one lost to a mudslide, or paying for a student's scholarship, or bringing urgent medical care to those without access.

Many impoverished families cannot afford the cost of clean water, and rely on dangerous, untreated water for drinking and washing. A filter provides a family with potable water and eliminates the health risks of drinking contaminated water.

68% of indigenous children are malnourished, and 21.5% of Guatemalans survive on less than \$1 a day.
